The Village of Edgerton Community Leadership Scholarship

The Village of Edgerton is offering a \$1000.00 scholarship based on academic merit, community involvement, and a commitment to rural Alberta communities. Applicants must be completing Grade 12 at the Edgerton Public School and plan to attend post-secondary or trades studies in Fall 2019.

Successful applicants will submit the following:

- Confirmation from Edgerton Public School, demonstrating academic excellence and Honour Roll status;
- Description of their volunteer and/or extra-curricular experience in the Edgerton community; and
- An essay, no more than 800 words, outlining the positive experience of growing up in the Edgerton area.

The successful recipient of the Village of Edgerton Community Leadership Scholarship will be awarded \$1000.00 following the end of the application timeline. A submitted report and list of the expenses incurred as they relate to post-secondary studies must be submitted no later than Friday, August 23, 2019. The submitted report should indicate costs of tuition or supplies that the Scholarship has or will be applied towards. The successful recipient's essay may be retained and used by the Village of Edgerton for its own purposes.

The application timeline for the Village of Edgerton Community Leadership Scholarship is April 17, 2019 – May 6, 2019. The successful recipient will be notified by Friday, May 10, 2019.
