BYLAW No. 04-25 "Repealing Bylaw Number 2 - 2025"

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF EDGERTON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING BYLAWS

THAT ARE NO LONGER EFFECTIVE

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provision of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, permits Council to repeal bylaws deemed inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective.

AND WHEREAS, Council has deemed it necessary to repeal bylaws believed to inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective.

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the provision of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, council must publicly advertise the repeal of bylaws.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Village of Edgerton in session duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw may be referred to as the "Repealing Bylaw Number 2 - 2025"

3.1 Should any provision of this Bylaw be found invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, that provision shall be severed, and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.

4. Effective Date

4.1 This Bylaw shall come into force upon receipt of its third and final reading.
